(500 words or less)	Students began receiving SEL services from a certified counselor. This was just the beginning of a relationship with Culver's counselors and opened the door to continued work with them.
2	What barriers, impediments, or challenges to your SIA implementation have you faced or identified that are helpful for your community and/or state leaders to be aware of? (500 words or less)	While we initially set out to hire a .4 FTE educational assistant, we were unable to do so due to funding decreases. It is difficult to find employees in our remote location. It is also quite difficult to find an employee willing to work just 6 hours a week. We were fortunate to have a current employee willing to take on the additional position.
3	SIA implementation includes ongoing engagement with focal students, the families of focal students, and educators. What successes and challenges, if any, have you experienced in maintaining engagement? (500 words or less)	Our community, students and parents are quite engaged with the school. There have not been any difficulties in keeping them engaged. The most difficult piece was the workload this grant created for staff.

Bringing in support staff to work directly with children was valued most by staff and board members.
